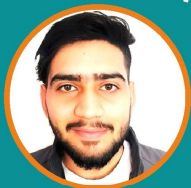

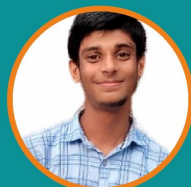

- Students selected for admission will be informed by the school.
- For admission in Nursery, Date of Birth Certificate (Parents attested photo copy) issued by Municipal Authority must be submitted along with the form.
- Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC/Minority) must be submitted along with the form.
- Students from other schools should provide a Photocopy of their previous school's report-card.
- For higher classes, original transfer Certificate issued by the previous school will be required at the time of confirmation of admission.
- Fake documents & certificates will lead to admission cancellation.
- Mere registration carries no guarantee of admission.
- The fee, once paid, will not be refunded.
- Documents (Photo copy) submitted with the registration cum admission form will not be returned.
- No student shall be admitted in class IX/XI, after 31st day of August for the session 2025-26 year except with prior permission of chairman / CBSE/ Competent Authority.

## Admission Procedure

1. To be part of Jyoti vidyapeeth Sr. Sec. School Bagar for the session 2025-26. You need to register the child by either personally or by collecting the registration cum admission form by paying Rs. 200/- from the school office or online <http://www.jvpbagar.edu.in>.
2. Duly filled registration form to be submitted at Administrative office with Rs. 2200 (2000 Admission Fee 200 form fee)
3. The forms can be purchased from the school office from Monday to Saturday between 7:30 am to 5:30pm.
4. Selections for classes pre Nursery - KG would be made on the basis of an informal interaction between parents and principal. There will be no written test. The date and time for informal interaction will be intimated to parents by school office.
5. For class I onwards the admission will be on the basis of an entrance test and an interaction with the principal.

# Code of Conduct for the students

# Sports Achievement : 2024-25



In this year, high standard grounds for hockey, archery (10-30 meters), table tennis, ludo and carrom have also been inaugurated in the school. 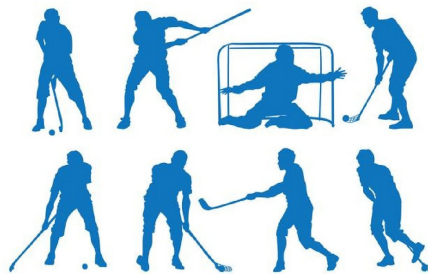

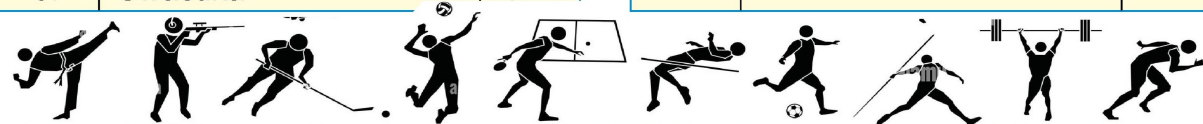

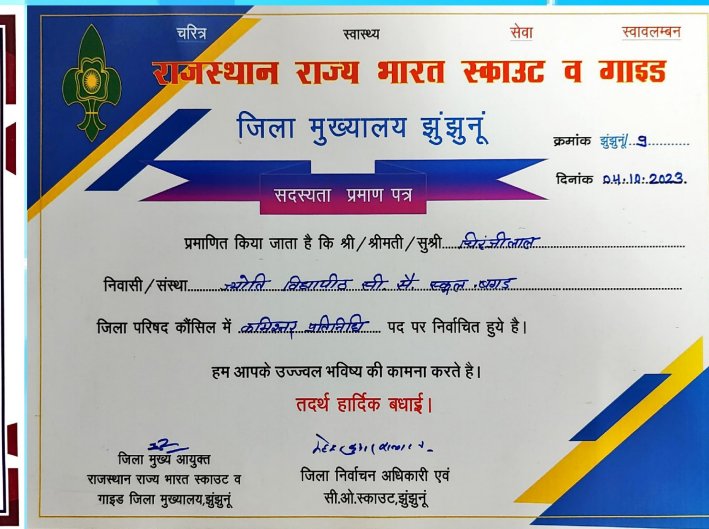
